This two day course is cooperately taught by a Code 3 instructor and a certified instructor of the National Wildfire Coordinating Group (NWCG). It will provide the student with the basic knowledge and safety skills needed to integrate with firefighters within the urban interface of wildland fire.

Instruction includes:

- S-130 Introduction to Wildland Fire Behavior
- S-190 Firefighter Training
- Scene Assessment for Animal Rescue Evacuation and Safety
- Practical Exercises

- Work/hiking boots, leather work gloves, safety helmet and clothing appropriate for current weather conditions
