

JULY 24-28, 2023 DISASTER RESPONSE OVERVIEW PROGRAM (DROP)

This forty-hour course is designed for first responders, animal control officers, law enforcement, and others that are involved in emergency or disaster response where animals are affected. It gives an introduction to just how much goes into effecting an efficient and safe response, and how the involvement of the animal creates more variables to be aware of. Largely hands-on, the student will benefit from real life scenarios and practical applications in handling and rescuing animals safely in various situations.

- Ropes And Knots
- Introduction To Water Operation and Boat Safety
- Hazardous Materials and Decontamination

- PFD, helmet for water and land, dry suit (wet suit acceptable)
- Work gloves
